Opinion

The summary financial statements of BALANCE For Blind Adults (the "BALANCE"), which comprise the summary balance sheet as at March 31, 2025 and the summary statement of revenues and expenses for the year then ended and related note, are derived from the audited financial statements of BALANCE for the year ended March 31, 2025.

In our opinion, the accompanying summary financial statements are a fair summary of the audited financial statements of BALANCE for the year ended March 31, 2025, on the basis described in the note to the summary financial statements.

Summary Financial Statements

The summary financial statements do not contain all the disclosures required by Canadian accounting standards for not-for-profit organizations. Reading the summary financial statements and the auditor's report thereon, therefore, is not a substitute for reading the audited financial statements of BALANCE and the auditor's report thereon.

The summary financial statements and the audited financial statements do not reflect the effects of events that occurred subsequent to the date of our report on the audited financial statements.

The Audited Financial Statements and Our Report Thereon

We expressed a qualified audit opinion on the audited financial statements in our reported dated June 23, 2025.

Our qualified audit opinion is based on the fact that in common with many similar organizations, BALANCE derives revenues from fund-raising events and donations, the completeness of which is not susceptible to satisfactory audit verification. Accordingly, our verification of these revenues was limited to the amounts recorded in the records of BALANCE. Therefore, we were not able to determine whether, as at and for the year ended March 31, 2025, any adjustments might be necessary to revenues and excess of revenues over expenses reported in the statements of revenues and expenses, and assets and net assets reported in the balance sheet.

Our audit opinion on the financial statements for the year ended March 31, 2024 was modified because of the possible effects of this scope limitation.

Management's Responsibility for the Summary Financial Statements

Management is responsible for the preparation of the summary financial statements on the basis described in the note to the summary financial statements.

Auditor's Responsibility

Our responsibility is to express an opinion on whether the summary financial statements are a fair summary of the audited financial statements based on our procedures, which were conducted in accordance with Canadian Auditing Standard (CAS) 810, *Engagements to Report on Summary Financial Statements*.
